If the last date of submission falls on a public holiday, the next working day shall be considered as the last day. The proposal received after the deadline shall not be accepted.
- 6. The proposal shall be evaluated based on internal criteria set by NCHL. Vendors who have already submitted their proposal will be considered for further evaluation and do not need to resubmit. NCHL reserves the right to accept or reject any or all applications without assigning any reason, whatsoever including receipt of insufficient number of proposals.

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
